Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Wednesday 02 June to 1200 UTC Thursday 03 June 2021

General Situation

A thundery low over biscay will move north or northwest towards Ireland today and weaken before moving west into the Atlantic on Thursday. This will allow a southeasterly flow across most parts initially, to gradually veer round to a southwesterly flow during Thursday and Friday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast, veering south later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 2 to 4 in north, otherwise easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight, becoming moderate at times later.

Occasional drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly veering southerly or southwesterly, 3 to 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

East 2 to 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Occasional drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East becoming variable for a time, 2 or 3, occasionally 4 later.

Slight.

Showers, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

East 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less later, occasionally 5 at first near Gibraltar Point.

Slight.

Showers later, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4.

Slight, occasionally smooth in south.

Showers later, perhaps thundery.

Good occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, but southerly at first in south, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming westerly or southwesterly 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery, fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in east, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in east.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming west 2 to 4 later.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Showers, thundery at first, fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest, veering northwest later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers at first.

Mainly good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming southwesterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west.

Slight or moderate in west, otherwise slight, occasionally smooth in lyme bay.

Showers, thundery at first, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later in east.

Slight or moderate in west, otherwise slight, occasionally smooth.

Fair.
Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Easterly at first in north, otherwise southwesterly, 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less at times in the Bristol Channel.

Smooth or slight in east, otherwise slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers, thundery at first, fog patches at first in west.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less at times in the Bristol Channel.

Smooth or slight at first in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering south or southwest, 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, thundery at first, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 to 5.

Slight occasionally moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly, veering southerly later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time in north.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, thundery at first, fog patches in west.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 at first in Liverpool Bay, otherwise southerly or southwesterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first in northwest.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Fair.

Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast, veering south later, 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, thundery at first, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in west.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4 at first in the North Channel, otherwise easterly or northeasterly, veering southeasterly later, 4 to 6.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers, thundery at first, fog patches in south.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly veering southerly or southwesterly, 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

- (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly veering southeasterly later, 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in the Firth of Clyde.

Showers, thundery at first, fog patches in the North Channel.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in the North Channel.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 to 6.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast, veering southeast later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering south later, 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time in north.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far north and in far south.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 at first in north, otherwise southeasterly veering southerly, 4 to 6.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in south.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming east or southeast, 3 to 5.

Moderate, occasionally slight later.
Showers later.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or 4 at first in north, otherwise southeasterly veering southerly, 4 to 6.
Moderate, occasionally slight.
Showers.
Mainly good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Wednesday 02 Jun 2021 at 1200 UTC until Thursday 03 Jun 2021 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation
High pressure centred over Scandinavia with ridge extending across Shetland Waters, maintaining a southeasterly airstream

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil.

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in west
Moderate, but slight in waters east of Shetland
Fog patches becoming mainly fair
Moderate occasionally very poor, becoming mainly good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Thursday 03 Jun until 1200 UTC on Thursday 03 Jun:
Southeast 4 or 5, decreasing 3 later in east
Moderate, but slight in waters east of Shetland
Mainly fair at first but fog patches later
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:
South to southeast 2 to 4, veering southwest to west 2 to 3 this evening and west to northwest overnight, locally variable.
Smooth or slight, with a low swell.
Isolated showers mist and fog patches, especially in the north of the area and more widely after dusk.
Moderate to good, locally poor or very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West to northwest 2 to 3, locally variable, becoming northerly or variable by dawn.
Smooth locally slight, with a low swell.
Mist and isolated fog patches with isolated showers, mainly in east of the area.
Moderate to good, locally poor, perhaps very poor especially in east of the area.

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
