Forecast for Saturday 09 Jul 2022

Weather: Rather cloudy at first but becoming sunny, with strong sunshine, by late morning. Staying warm overnight too.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 60% first thing becoming 100% by mid-morning.

Low cloud and visibility: Patch cloud with bases of around 600m will cover mainly northern and western hills first thing before lifting by late-morning, and leaving cloudless skies by this afternoon.

Meteorologist's View

Warm temperatures, strong sunshine and high UV levels bring a risk of dehydration and heat stress, especially on long climbs.

Forecast for Sunday 10 Jul 2022

Weather: Patchy cloud may arrive overnight, but cloud will quickly clear through the morning to leave a dry and very warm day with prolonged strong sunshine.

Maximum wind: Northeast 15-20 mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops 600m: Perhaps briefly 70% at first, soon becoming 100%.

Low cloud and visibility: Excellent, apart for a chance patchy low cloud covering some summits at first.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 8 Celsius, becoming Plus 27 Celsius.
At 600m: Plus 10 Celsius becoming Plus 18 Celsius.
Freezing level: Above the summits.
