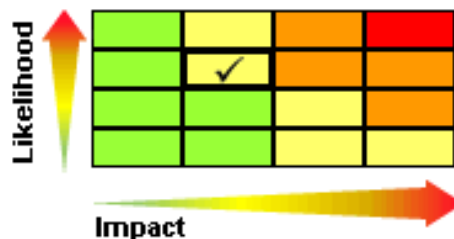
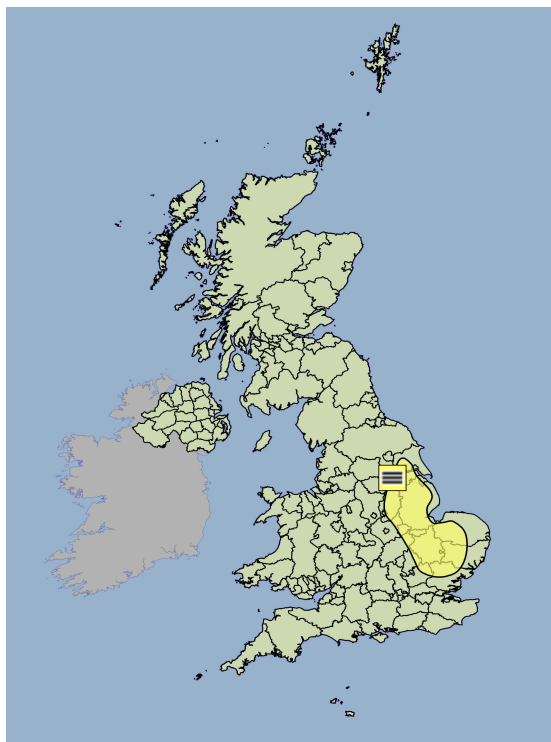




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

Fog has formed in a slack, moist air mass overnight leaving visibility reduced to below 100 metres at times. Some locally dense fog patches are expected during the morning rush hour. Fog will lift and clear fairly readily this morning and should have largely cleared by mid to late morning.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Fog**

Valid from **04:00 on Fri, 11th Mar 2016** until **09:00 on Fri, 11th Mar 2016**

Areas of fog have formed overnight and some locally dense fog and freezing fog patches are expected during the morning rush hour.

Please be aware of the likelihood of some travel disruption and difficult driving conditions.
