Forecast for Monday 07 Aug 2023

Weather: Dry with clear spells over inland ranges but cloudy with scattered showers over coastal ranges overnight. Coastal showers spread inland during the morning leaving sunny spells interspersed with showers well into the evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Cloud will be broken 500-700m throughout the day with visibility good away from cloud and showers.

Forecast for Tuesday 08 Aug 2023

Weather: After a dry start showers build through the morning, these mainly across northern ranges and interspersed with sunny spells. These showers clear from the late afternoon to leave a dry and bright evening.

Maximum wind: West 15-20mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 60%

Low cloud and visibility: Broken cloud 600-700m will become patchy towards the evening. The visibility will be good away from the cloud and showers.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 6 Celsius rising to plus 17Celsius.

At 800m: Plus 5 Celsius.

Freezing level: Above the summits.
