General Situation

A deep slow moving Atlantic low to the south of Iceland, will keep brisk mainly westerly winds across the United Kingdom through the coming days.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southwest 4 or 5, then veering west 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers, but rain for a time later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough in far north.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3, becoming west or southwest 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in far north.

Showers, but rain for a time later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Westerly or southwesterly, 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 for a time.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

West or southwest, 6 to gale 8, occasionally 5 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far west.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest, 6 to gale 8, veering west or northwest 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in west.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 later in south.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far southwest.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 4 or 5, but southwesterly 6 to gale 8 at first in south.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far southwest.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in far south, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, then backing west 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 or 6, backing southwest 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 5 or 6, becoming west or northwest 6 or 7, then decreasing 5 or 6 later.

Slight becoming moderate or rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 or 6, backing southwest 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 4 or 5, veering westerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough later in far north.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north.

Rough or very rough in far north, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 4 or 5, veering westerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough later near Mull of Kintyre.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Westerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north.
Slight or moderate, but rough near Mull of Kintyre.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South, veering west, 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first.
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough later in west.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West 5 or 6, backing southwest 6 to gale 8 later.
Rough or very rough, becoming high in far west.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6, veering westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or southwest 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough.
Showers.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6, veering westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7.
Rough, becoming very rough later in west.
Rain or showers.

West or southwest 5 to 7.
Rough or very rough, becoming high in west.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A slack flow will cover Shetland and surrounding waters today. A weather front will push northeast through Shetland early on Wednesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue

North or northwest becoming variable 3 or 4.
Moderate or rough.
Mainly fair, perhaps the odd shower.
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Tuesday 05 Nov until 0600 UTC on Wednesday

06 Nov:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming south 4 or 5, veering southwest 4 or 5 in west later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest to west 5 to 6 increasing 6 to 7 this morning, backing west to southwest overnight, decreasing 4 to 5 for a time.

Rather rough to rough, locally moderate for a time overnight.

Rain at times, mostly at first and again overnight.

Good, locally moderate to poor in rain.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 6 to 7, backing southwest in the morning, decreasing 5 to 6 overnight, veering west further decreasing 4 towards morning.

Rather rough to rough, moderating a little later.

Patchy rain, becoming more persistent overnight.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor in rain.
