General Situation

High pressure persists to the east of the United Kingdom. A frontal trough to the west will move slowly and erratically east to affect western areas on Thursday and some eastern areas on Friday morning.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

Variable 3, becoming southeasterly 3 or 4 for a time in east.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers, fog patches in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in east.

Fog patches in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly veering westerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in east.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in Strait of Dover at first.

Fog patches in east, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in east.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering west or southwest 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

Thundery rain, fog patches, then showers.

Slight, occasionally smooth in east.

Thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Variable becoming south or southwest 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.
Thundery rain, fog patches, then showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.
