Forecast for Sunday 06 Jun 2021

Weather: Showers clearing north in the early hours. Any early low cloud breaking up soon after dawn and then burning off before mid morning. Good sunny spells through the day.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 40% until shortly after dawn, then rising to more than 95% by mid morning.

Visibility: Locally very poor due to a few banks of low cloud at 500-750m overnight. Once this burns off then remaining very good for the rest of the day.

Forecast for Monday 07 Jun 2021

Weather: A mainly dry day with some sunny spells. Chance of an isolated afternoon shower.

Maximum wind: Southerly 15-20mph.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: More than 90%.

Visibility: Very good

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 6 Celsius peaking at Plus 19 Celsius in the afternoon.

At 800m: Plus 8 Celsius rising to Plus 11 Celsius

Freezing level: Above the summits.
