General Situation

High pressure will persist over Scandinavia with a thundery area of low pressure to the southwest of the United Kingdom. Between these two pressure systems, a brisk easterly airflow will persist.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 3 or 4, veering southeast 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, but smooth in Moray Firth.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time, becoming variable 3 later.

Smooth in Moray Firth at first, otherwise slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure covers Shetland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

North or northeast veering east 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Fair with a risk of mist patches.

Good occasionally poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Monday 02 May until 1200 UTC on Monday 02

May:

East veering south 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Fair with a risk of mist patches.

Good occasionally poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East to northeast, 3 or 4 in the south, 5 or 6 in the north, occasionally 7 late Monday morning.

Slight in the south to rather rough in the north.

Scattered thundery showers some mist or fog patches on Monday morning.

Moderate to good, locally poor in showers and very poor in fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East to northeast 5 to 7 in the north and 4 in the south, decreasing generally 3 or 4 on Tuesday.

Mainly moderate to rather rough, becoming slight to moderate on Tuesday.

Scattered showers with a risk of thunder some mist patches on Tuesday.

Moderate to good, locally moderate to poor at times.

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
