General Situation

High pressure over the United Kingdom on Tuesday will move slowly east to be centred over the southern North Sea during Wednesday.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4, then southeast later.

Moderate occasionally rough for a time.

Wintry showers at first.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast veering west 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

Fair, occasional rain later.

Good occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering northwest later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in North Channel at first.
Slight or moderate.
Rain for a time.
Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly veering northwesterly later, 4 or 5 occasionally 6 in west at first.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in north.

Good, but poor in snow.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Wednesday 03 Mar until 1200 UTC on
Wednesday 03 Mar:

Northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 or less in west.
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in southeast.
Snow showers dying out.
Good, but poor in snow.

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
