General Situation

Pressure will remain relatively high over the United Kingdom. Atlantic fronts affecting northwestern areas at times, will extend southeastwards during Sunday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time in north and east, becoming variable later in Moray

Firth.

Smooth or slight, but moderate for a time in northwest.

Showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, but southeasterly 4 at times in north and east.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, but southeasterly 4 at first in north.

Smooth.

Fog patches, showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches and showers developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Easterly, veering southeasterly in north, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Mainly east or southeast 3 or 4.

Smooth.

Showers later, fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight becoming smooth.

Fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly becoming variable 3, occasionally 4.

Smooth, becoming slight in west.

Showers later, fog patches developing.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 4 or 5, becoming variable or southeast 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Fair.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable mainly east or southeast 3.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, becoming variable then northerly later, 3 or 4, but 5 for a time at first near headlands.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth in east.

Fog patches and drizzle for a time later in far west.

Good becoming moderate or poor, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 3 or 4.

Slight in east, moderate in west.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, veering west later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Fog patches and drizzle later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable or westerly 3 or 4.

Smooth becoming slight in east, but moderate in west.
Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly, becoming variable then mainly southerly, 3 or 4, but occasionally 5 at first near great orme head.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches and drizzle later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later near St Davids Head.

Fog patches, occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, becoming variable later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming mainly northwesterly later, 3 or less.

Smooth.

Fog patches, occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast veering southeast for a time 3 or 4, increasing 4 or 5 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Showers for a time later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 or 4, veering south or southwest 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time in north, becoming variable 3 later.

Smooth or slight, but moderate for a time in north.

Rain then showers, fog patches later in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, fog patches in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time in North Channel,

becoming variable 3 later.
Smooth or slight, but moderate for a time in North Channel.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable becoming mainly northwesterly 3 or less.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time, becoming variable 3 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or showers.
Good becoming moderate, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable becoming mainly northwesterly 3 or less.
Slight or moderate, but smooth in shelter.
Occasional rain.
Moderate , occasionally poor.

The Minch
24 hour forecast:
East or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, becoming variable 3 later.
Smooth or slight, but moderate for a time in south and far north.
Rain or showers later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath
24 hour forecast:
East or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, becoming variable 3 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or showers later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable or southerly 3, occasionally 4 in west.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or poor.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
High pressure to the north of Shetland drifts north through the next 24 hours.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate.

Fair, isolated fog patches.
Good, perhaps locally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Friday 04 Jun until 0000 UTC on Saturday 05 Jun:

Easterly veering southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west.

Mainly slight.

Fair, isolated fog patches.

Good, perhaps locally very poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

East 4, locally 5 in the north at first, veering southeast decreasing 3 to 4 by dawn, becoming variable 1

or 2 during the morning then north to northeast 3 to 4 for a time in the afternoon.

Slight, locally moderate at first.

Fair or fine.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable or north to northwest 1 to 3.

Smooth or slight.

Risk of a shower and sea fog patches, especially later.

Moderate to good, perhaps locally poor later.

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
