General Situation

A complex, deepening area of low pressure will move northeastwards across the United Kingdom today, with pressure then building in its wake on Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southwest becoming variable 3 or 4, then becoming west 4 or 5 later.

Moderate in north, slight or moderate in south.

Showers, occasionally thundery.

Good, but poor for a time at first in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 or 5 becoming variable 2 or 3.

Moderate in north, slight or moderate in south.

Showers.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming westerly 4 or 5 later, occasionally 6 later in south.

Mainly slight.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 or 5 becoming variable 2 or 3.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South backing southeast 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic then northwest 5 to 7 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain or thundery showers, becoming fair later.

Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South backing southeast 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic then northwest 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or thundery showers, becoming fair later.

Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly backing southeasterly 4 or 5, then veering westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair then rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3 then northeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 4 veering southwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time later, veering westerly or northwesterly 4 later.

Slight becoming moderate, then rough for a time later.

Fair then thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 3 or 4 becoming variable 2 or 3, then becoming northeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Moderate becoming slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5 veering southwest 7 to severe gale 9, then veering west 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time.

Rain or thundery showers, becoming fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 or 5 becoming variable 2 or 3.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Showers for a time.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly becoming cyclonic 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in east, then becoming westerly 4 or 5.

Moderate occasionally rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain or thundery showers, becoming fair.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West becoming variable 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Mainly slight.

Showers for a time.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic becoming west or northwest, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, but rough for a time at first near land's end.

Rain or thundery showers, becoming fair.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 2 or 3.

Mainly slight.

Showers for a time.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 4 or 5 becoming northwest 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or thundery showers, becoming fair.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 2 or 3.

Mainly slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic then northwest 5 to 7, backing west 4 or 5 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain or thundery showers, becoming fair.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 or 5 backing southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming northwest 5 or 6, then backing west 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain then fair.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest backing east or southeast, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 for a time.

Slight.

Fair.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in North Channel, backing westerly 4 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers then fair.

Good, but occasionally poor at first in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West backing south 4, becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

Mainly slight.

Showers.

Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in North Channel, backing westerly 4 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, but occasionally poor at first in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West backing south 4, becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

Mainly slight.

Showers.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming west or northwest 4 or 5 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable mainly southwest 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Showers.

Good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

South veering west or southwest, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in north, becoming variable 2 or 3.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

South veering west or southwest, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times later.

Moderate, but occasionally slight near Sutherland and between barra and canna.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in north, becoming variable 2 or 3.

Moderate, but occasionally slight between barra and canna.

Showers.

Good.

Valid Monday 05 Aug 2013 at 0600 UTC until Monday 05 Aug 2013 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

An easing southwesterly flow. A low moves northeast across the East Shetland Basin through Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southwest, becoming variable 3 or 4, then north 4 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.
Occasional rain in east.
Good, occasionally moderate in east.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 05 Aug until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 06 Aug:
North backing west 4.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.
Occasional rain in east.
Good, occasionally moderate in east.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 4 to 6, locally 7 for a time this morning, veering west or southwest 4 or 5 by mid afternoon, decreasing 3 or 4 this evening, becoming north or northwest 2 or 3 by dawn.

Slight or moderate, locally rather rough at times.
Occasional rain, perhaps locally heavy in the north, dying out by early afternoon, then risk of a shower.
Good, occasionally moderate or poor in rain.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable or northerly 1 to 3.
Mainly slight, with a low swell at first.
Slight risk of a shower.
Good.

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
