



# National Severe Weather Warning Service



**Chief Forecasters Assessment**  
 Yet another intense depression will be bearing down on the British Isles later on Thursday, threatening some potentially disruptive weather. There is the risk of gusts of more than 70 mph almost anywhere in the UK and heavy rain could cause localised flooding. However, confidence at this stage is low in the location of areas affected.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Alert of Wind**

Valid from **18:00 on Thu, 15th Dec 2011** until **23:59 on Fri, 16th Dec 2011**

Rapidly strengthening winds and heavy rain are likely to arrive across the west later on Thursday and through Friday, heralding another potentially stormy period.

The public is advised to monitor warnings for this period, noting that the warning may be upgraded.
