



National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment
 Rain will turn to snow over higher hills during Thursday daytime and then to some lower levels during Thursday night. A few centimetres of snow may affect higher routes before a slow improvement follows during Friday daytime. At lower levels, snow will probably struggle to settle on tarmac and concrete surfaces. Some icy patches are also possible.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Snow**

Valid from **21:00 on Thu, 29th Mar 2018** until **12:00 on Fri, 30th Mar 2018**

Headline: Snow for some parts on Thursday night, mainly over hills.
 What To Expect: Some roads likely to be affected with longer journey times, mainly across higher routes.
