### Forecast for Friday 09 Dec 2022

**Weather:** Dry and clear overnight, perhaps some low level mist and freezing fog patches. Then a dry day with long spells of sunshine, especially through the morning with a little more cloud in the afternoon. Risk of one or two light snow showers in the evening.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m:** Close to 100% through much of the day, chances fall a little through the evening.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Little or no cloud below the summits until evening with visibility very good or excellent, perhaps a kilometre or less in any low level mist and fog patches and any evening snow showers.

**Meteorologist's View**

**Forecast for Saturday 10 Dec 2022**

**Weather:** A few snow showers possible but most places dry with some good spells of sunshine.

**Maximum wind:** Westerly winds around 10mph or less

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m:** Around 60%

**Low cloud and visibility:** Occasional or periods of cloud above about 600m. Otherwise visibility very good falling to around a kilometre at times in snow showers.

**Temperature:** **Valleys:** Minus 4 or 5 Celsius overnight, rising to plus 3 or 4 Celsius by day  
**At 600m:** Around minus 3 Celsius  
**Freezing level:** Around 300m
