#### General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will continue to extend east across the United Kingdom. Weak fronts over southeastern parts are now slow-moving. It will become increasingly unsettled later in the northwest.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly backing southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north.

Rough or very rough north and west of Orkney, otherwise moderate becoming slight.

Squally showers in northwest.

Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 in Moray Firth.

Rough or very rough north and west of Orkney, otherwise slight.

Rain or showers in northwest.

Good, occasionally poor in northwest.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Westerly backing southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in north.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in south, backing westerly 3 or 4 later.

Moderate becoming slight.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

Slight, occasionally moderate further offshore.

Occasional rain or drizzle in east until later, otherwise mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first further offshore.

Showers later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 6 to gale 8 veering northeasterly 5 or 6.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers in far west.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in east.

Rough in far west, otherwise slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 6 or 7 decreasing 4 or 5.

Slight inner Bristol Channel, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers in west.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 or 5, decreasing 3 later.  
Rough in far southwest, otherwise slight or moderate.  
Showers in west.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in south, veering northeasterly 3 or 4.  
Moderate becoming smooth or slight.  
Showers in west.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northeasterly, veering easterly, then becoming variable, 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers in west.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway  
24 hour forecast:  
North 4 or 5, veering east or southeast 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first near great orme head.  
Showers in far west.

Isle of Man

North or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 3 later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwesterly 4 or 5 in north, variable 3 in south.  
Moderate or rough in north, otherwise smooth or slight.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Northwesterly 4 or 5 backing southwesterly 3 or 4.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near Mull of Kintyre.

#### Shetland Isles

General Situation  
Showery troughs continue to track east over Shetland waters with high pressure to the south.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southwesterly gale force 8

Westerly backing southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in west and north.  
Rough or very rough but moderate in lee of east Shetland.  
Showers, squally at times in west.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Wednesday 03 Dec until 1800 UTC on Wednesday 03 Dec:

Southwesterly 5 to 7 occasionally gale 8 at first.

Rough or very rough but moderate close to lee of east Shetland.

Isolated showers at first, occasional rain later in west.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North to northeast 6 to 7, locally gale 8, decreasing 5 to 6 by Wednesday afternoon.

Rather rough to rough, decreasing moderate to rather rough later.

Occasional rain.

Moderate to good, locally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
