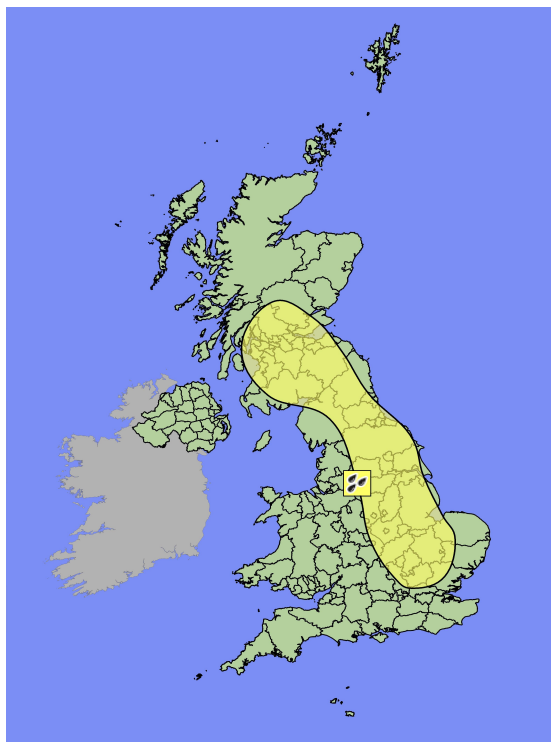




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

A warm humid airmass is covering much of England. As a cold front moves slowly eastwards across some western areas of Britain today some heavy thundery downpours are likely to be triggered further to the east. Although many places will miss the downpours, where they do occur there is the possibility of 25mm of rain falling in an hour leading to localised surface water flooding.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **14:00 on Wed, 04th Jul 2012** until **23:55 on Wed, 04th Jul 2012**

Scattered heavy thundery downpours are likely on Wednesday afternoon and evening. The public should be aware that these could lead to localised surface water flooding and difficult driving conditions. Note that this warning has been updated to include southern and central Scotland and more of east and northeast England.
