Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0000 UTC Thursday 03 June to 0000 UTC Friday 04 June 2021

#### General Situation

A humid airstream will bring fog patches and showery rain at times, perhaps thundery, especially in eastern waters. A ridge of high pressure will build across western areas on Thursday, bringing increasingly fine conditions here.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight in south.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

East, veering south later, 3 to 5.

Moderate becoming slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, backing southeast later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first near Rattray Head.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

East 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Thundery showers later.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Slight.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

East 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming north or northwest 3 or 4.  
Slight, occasionally smooth later.  
Rain or thundery showers, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southerly or southwesterly, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly, becoming variable, then northwesterly later, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 for a time near North Foreland.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly becoming variable, 2 to 4, then becoming westerly 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, veering northwest 3 or less later.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest backing west, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Rain at times in east.

Good, occasionally poor in east.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Fog patches at first in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming south or southwest, 2 to 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in west.

Fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable at times in Bristol Channel, otherwise southwesterly, 2 to 4, occasionally 5 in west.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in Bristol Channel.  
Fog patches at first.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable in Bristol Channel, otherwise south or southwest, 2 to 4.  
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight in east.  
Fair.  
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Cyclonic, becoming southerly or southwesterly, 3 to 5, increasing 6 for a time in north.  
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.  
Fog patches at first.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 5 at first.  
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Easterly, veering southerly or southwesterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, but becoming variable 2 to 4 in Liverpool Bay.  
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later in north.  
Showers and fog patches, becoming fair later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southwesterly, becoming variable in south, 2 to 4, occasionally 5 at first in north.  
Moderate at first in north, otherwise smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
East, veering south or southwest, 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.  
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate later.  
Fog patches, rain at first, becoming fair later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.  
Moderate, becoming slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Easterly veering southeasterly, then southerly later, 4 to 6, occasionally 7 for a time in east.  
Slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain at first, fog patches at first in south.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South 3 to 5.  
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight in east.  
Showers in north.  
Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel  
- (SWW)

24 hour forecast:  
Easterly or northeasterly, veering southerly or southeasterly, 4 to 6.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in the Firth of Clyde.  
Fog patches in North Channel, otherwise occasional rain, becoming fair later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later in the North Channel.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly 3 to 5.  
Slight, occasionally moderate.  
Fair.  
Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:  
East veering southeast, then south later, 4 to 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain at first.  
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South 4 to 6, backing southeast 3 to 5 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:  
East or northeast 3 to 5, veering south or southeast 4 to 6.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far north and in far south.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southeast 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate in south.  
Fair then showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:  
East or northeast 3 to 5, veering south or southeast 4 to 6.  
Moderate, occasionally slight later in north.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southeast 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.  
Moderate, occasionally slight in north.

Fair then showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Thursday 03 Jun 2021 at 0000 UTC until Thursday 03 Jun 2021 at 1200 UTC

#### Shetland Isles

##### General Situation

High pressure centred over Scandinavia with ridge extending across Shetland Waters maintaining a southeasterly airstream

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil.

Southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in west  
Moderate in west, slight in the east.  
Mainly fair, but a few fog patches developing.  
Moderate or good occasionally very poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Thursday 03 Jun until 0000 UTC on Friday 04 Jun:

Southeast 3 or 4  
Slight but moderate in far west.  
Fog patches  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor

#### Channel Islands

##### 24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 3 to 4, locally variable 1 to 3, becoming northwest to north by evening, perhaps occasionally 5 in the southeast later.  
Smooth or slight with a low swell.  
Risk of mist or fog patches, mainly in the north of the area at first occasional rain or showers after dawn, mainly in the east of the area.  
Moderate to good, perhaps locally poor or very poor at first.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 3 to 4, occasionally 5 in the southeast at first, backing northwest by dawn and westerly by midday.  
Smooth or slight with a low swell.  
Occasional rain or showers, mainly in the east of the area, clearing by midday.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

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
