### Forecast for Wednesday 01 Dec 2021

**Weather:** Bright intervals with occasional showers in the morning, falling as sleet or snow above 600m. Some showers could be heavy in the morning with hail and a small risk of thunder. Becoming mainly dry by the afternoon with clear spells for a time early evening before cloud increases late evening.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m:** 30% in morning becoming 80% in afternoon.

**Visibility:** Occasionally poor in the morning above 600 or 700m due to low cloud and occasional showers reducing visibility to less than 100m at times. Very good on lower slopes between showers and becoming more generally good at all levels during the afternoon.

**Meteorologist's View**

A severe wind chill at height. Slippery and icy conditions on summits and ridges.

**Forecast for Thursday 02 Dec 2021**

**Weather:** Wintry showers overnight, clearing by dawn. Cold and dry with long bright or sunny spells during the day but high cloud increasing later. Outbreaks of sleet or snow will spread east during the evening, turning to rain on low slopes.

**Maximum wind:** North or NW 20mph gusts 30mph in the morning, easing Westerly 10 to 15mph in the afternoon.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m:** 20% for a time overnight, otherwise 95%. Falling to 10% during evening as snow spreads east.

**Visibility:** Poor in early hours, otherwise very good during the day. Cloud becoming extensive again in the evening down to 200 or 300m.

**Temperature:** **Valleys:** Minus 1C rising to 3 or 4C.  
**At 800m:** Minus 3 or 4C, rising to Plus 1C late evening.  
**Freezing level:** 200 or 300m, slowly rising to 900m late evening.
