Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0001 UTC to 2359 UTC

General Situation

High pressure will persist across the United Kingdom during Sunday, with a weak cold front gradually losing its identity across Wales and central England. Meanwhile, a weak warm front will push eastwards across Scotland.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northwest backing southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 later.

Occasional drizzle later in north.

Good, occasionally moderate in drizzle.

Moderate, occasionally rough in north, becoming slight in Moray Firth.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

West backing southwest 3, increasing 4 or 5 later.

Fair.

Mainly good.

Slight or moderate, but rough at first north of Aberdeen.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

West 3 backing southwest 4.

Fair, risk of mist patches later.

Mainly good, occasionally poor in mist.

Slight or moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

North 3 backing southwest 3 or 4.

Fair, risk of mist patches later.

Mainly good, occasionally poor in mist.

Slight or moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less.

Fair, risk of mist patches later.

Mainly good, occasionally poor in mist.

Slight or moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less.

Fair, risk of mist patches at first and later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in mist.

Smooth or slight.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 3 or less.

Fair, risk of mist patches at first and later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in mist.

Smooth or slight.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 3 or 4.
Fair, risk of mist patches at first and later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor in mist.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate west of Lands End.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less.
Occasional drizzle.
Moderate or good.
Slight.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
Northeast 3 or less veering southwest 3 or 4.
Occasional drizzle.
Moderate or good.
Slight.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less, becoming southwest 4 or 5 later.
Occasional drizzle.
Moderate or good.
Slight.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
Variable becoming south to southwest 3 or less, increasing 4 later.
Mainly fair.
Good.
Smooth or slight.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less becoming southwest 4 or 5.
Occasional drizzle.
Moderate or good.
Slight in south, moderate or rough in north.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less becoming southwesterly 4 or 5.
Occasional drizzle.
Moderate or good.
Slight or moderate, but rough at first in North Channel.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Southeast 3 or less veering south 3 or 4 then southwest 5 or 6.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Good becoming moderate or poor.
Moderate or rough.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 3 or less increasing 5 to 7.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Good becoming moderate or poor.
Moderate or rough.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming south 4 or 5, veering southwest 6 or 7 later.

Showers, with rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Rough, occasionally moderate later.

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
