General Situation

An area of low pressure currently centred close to southeastern England will remain slow-moving during the next 24 hours before moving away slowly eastwards on Wednesday night. A transient ridge of high pressure will follow from the west.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7 decreasing 3 or 4, then becoming variable later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming southeasterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 later in north.

Slight or moderate becoming rough or very rough.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 5 to 7 backing northwest 4 or 5, then west 2 or 3 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 2 or 3 backing south 4 or 5, then southeast 6 to gale 8.

Slight or moderate becoming rough or very rough.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 5 or 6 backing northwest 4 or 5, then west 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 3 backing south 4 or 5, then southeast 6 to gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming north 5 or 6, then backing northwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest backing south 3 or 4, then backing southeast 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northerly backing northwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwesterly 4 or 5 backing westerly 3 or 4, then backing southerly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.
Showers then fair, rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, then decreasing 3 later in west.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers, becoming fair later.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwesterly 3 or 4 becoming variable 2 or 3, then southerly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.
Slight becoming moderate, then rough later.
Rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis
24 hour forecast:
North or northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less later.
Slight or moderate, becoming slight.
Showers then fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less becoming south 4 or 5, then increasing 6 to gale 8.
Slight becoming moderate, then rough later.
Rain later.
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west, veering northerly 3 or 4, then backing southwesterly later.
Rough at first west of land's end, otherwise slight or moderate.
Showers, thundery at first in west.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 3 or 4 backing south 6 to gale 8, then veering southwest again later.
Slight or moderate, becoming rough.
Fair then rain.
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwest 5 or 6 veering north 3 or 4, then becoming variable 2, then southwest 4 or 5 later.
Moderate or rough at first near Cornwall, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers, thundery at first in west.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 4 or 5 backing south 6 to gale 8, then veering southwest again later.
Slight, becoming moderate or rough.
Showers then rain.
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
North 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 2 or 3, then south 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers, thundery at first.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southeast 4 or 5 increasing 6 to gale 8, then veering south or southwest later.
Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough.
Showers then rain.
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
North or northeast 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4, then becoming variable 2, then southeast 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming slight.
Showers then fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 3 or 4 increasing 6 to gale 8.
Slight, becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in northwest.
Fair then rain.
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
North or northeast 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4, then becoming variable 2, then southeast 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming slight.
Showers then fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 3 or 4 increasing 6 to gale 8.
Slight becoming moderate, then rough or very rough.
Fair then rain.
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
North 5 or 6 veering northeast 3 or 4, then becoming variable 2, then southeast 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers then fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5 increasing 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in North Channel.
Slight or moderate becoming rough or very rough.

Fair then rain.
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

North 4 or 5 veering northeast 3 or 4, then becoming variable 2, then southeast 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 4 or 5 increasing 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in North Channel.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in North Channel.

Fair then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, veering east 3 or 4, then southeast 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 or 6 increasing 7 to severe gale 9.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough.

Fair then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5 veering east 3 or 4, then southeast 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough at first in north, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 to 7 increasing 7 to severe gale 9.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in south.

Fair then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5 veering east 3 or 4, then southeast 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 to 7 increasing 7 to severe gale 9.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough.

Fair then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Wednesday 05 Nov 2014 at 0000 UTC until Wednesday 05 Nov 2014 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low pressure to the southeast will move away southwards as a ridge to the north or northwest declines. Meanwhile, a deep low will track northeast towards Iceland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Northeasterly gale force 8 in operation at time of issue.

Northerly or northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in east.
Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate later.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Wednesday 05 Nov until 0000 UTC on Thursday 06 Nov:
Northeast veering southeast 5 or 6, decreasing 4 for a time.
Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest to north 4 to 5, locally 6 at times, veering north and decreasing mainly 4 by afternoon, becoming variable 1 to 3 during the evening.
Moderate, locally rather rough, becoming slight in the afternoon.
Isolated showers in the morning.
Good or very good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 1 to 3, becoming southerly and increasing 4 to 5 before dawn, increasing 5 to 6 in the morning, further increasing 6 to 7 during the afternoon.
Slight to moderate with swell, increasing rather rough to rough during the afternoon.
Occasional rain spreading from the west in the afternoon, becoming heavier and more persistent during the evening.
Good, locally moderate to poor in rain.
