Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1800 UTC to 1800 UTC

General Situation

Low pressure moves southeastwards across northern Scotland tonight, driving its frontal system across the United Kingdom. An Atlantic frontal trough will affect the southwest later Tuesday, and most southern areas on Wednesday.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Westerly backing southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Rain then wintry showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Northwest veering northeast then south 3 or 4.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
