Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1200 UTC Saturday 03 June to 1200 UTC Sunday 04 June 2017

#### General Situation

A slow-moving area of low pressure centred to the south of Iceland will bring an unsettled flavour to the weather over the next few days as Atlantic weather systems cross the British Isles from west to east. There are increasing indications of a deep area of low pressure bringing disturbed and windy weather northeastwards on Monday.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly east or southeast veering south or southwest later, 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in north.  
Showers, occasionally thundery, fog patches in east.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly south backing east later, 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in north.  
Showers, occasionally thundery.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming south or southwest 3 or 4.  
Smooth in shelter, otherwise slight.  
Showers, occasionally thundery at first, fog patches until later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4, backing southeast 4 or 5 later.  
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.  
Showers, thundery at first, rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming west or southwest 3 or 4.  
Slight.  
Showers and fog patches, becoming fair.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing south 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate later.  
Showers, rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly west or southwest, 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers for a time.  
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming south 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.  
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.  
Showers.

Mainly good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, backing southerly 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Fair then showers.

Mainly good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Fair then showers.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in the solent.

Smooth at times in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair then showers.

Mainly good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4, backing south or southwest 4 or 5 later.

Smooth at times in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers at first, occasional rain later.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough in west.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, backing south or southwest later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight in east, otherwise moderate.

Showers at first, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.  
Showers at first, rain later.  
Good, occasionally poor later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, fair for a time.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later in west.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time later.

Smooth or slight becoming slight or moderate.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, veering west or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Mainly slight.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight becoming moderate, occasionally rough later.

Showers, then rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in north.

Showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight for a time in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Thundery showers then occasional rain.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate in northwest, otherwise smooth or slight.

Showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6 later.  
Smooth or slight for a time in south, otherwise slight or moderate.  
Thundery showers, then occasional rain.  
Good, occasionally poor later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

South veering southwest 4 or 5.  
Rough at first in northwest and slight in shelter, otherwise moderate.  
Showers, thundery at first.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6 later.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate.  
Showers then occasional rain.  
Good, occasionally poor later.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4 veering south 4 or 5.  
Smooth or slight until later in central areas, otherwise slight or moderate.  
Showers, occasionally thundery.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest backing north or northeast later, 4 or 5.  
Smooth or slight in central areas, otherwise slight or moderate.  
Showers, thundery at first, occasional rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4 veering south 4 or 5.  
Moderate, occasionally rough at first.  
Showers, occasionally thundery.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest backing north or northeast later, 4 or 5.  
Moderate.  
Showers, thundery at first, occasional rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Saturday 03 Jun 2017 at 1200 UTC until Sunday 04 Jun 2017 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Generally unsettled with a risk of sea fog, but with relatively little wind.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in far southwest.

Slight in sheltered east, otherwise moderate, and becoming rough at times in far northwest.

Rain or showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Sunday 04 Jun until 1200 UTC on Sunday 04

Jun:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south and west.

Slight in sheltered east, otherwise moderate, and becoming rough at times in far northwest.

Rain or showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West 3 to 4, increasing 4 to 5 this evening, decreasing 2 to 3 by dawn on Sunday and backing south by midday.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or variable 2 to 4, becoming generally southwest to south Sunday evening, increasing 6 to 7 during Monday morning, perhaps gale f8 with gusts to 50kt.

Smooth or slight, with a low swell, becoming moderate to rather rough Monday morning.

Isolated showers, clearing overnight rain spreading from the west Monday morning.

Good, occasionally moderate in showers and rain.

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
