General Situation

Low pressure over southeast England will move slowly away southeastwards into Germany. A ridge of high pressure, extending from Iceland, will cover northern areas of the United Kingdom. A new Atlantic low will move northeast towards Northern Ireland during Tuesday with fronts affecting most areas by that time.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough in east.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming easterly 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, rain later in south.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

North 4 or 5, veering south or southeast, 3 or 4.

Moderate, occasionally rough near Rattray Head at first.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

North 4 or 5, veering south or southeast, 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Moderate.

Mainly fair, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

North 4 or 5, backing southwest 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, fair later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing southeast, 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Moderate.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, becoming variable then southerly, 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain then showers, fair later.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, veering southwesterly later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 5 to 7, becoming variable then southeasterly, 3 or 4.

Moderate, occasionally rough in east at first, becoming slight later.

Rain, then mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight becoming moderate.

Fair at first then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North, 5 or 6, becoming variable then southeast, 3 or 4.

Moderate becoming slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight becoming moderate.

Rain, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 4 or 5, becoming variable 3, then southeast 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering southwest, 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North becoming variable, 3 or 4, then becoming southeast 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering southwest, 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Rain then showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
Northeast becoming variable, then southeast, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers, rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast veering southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Slight or moderate.
Rain then showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
Northeast becoming variable then southeast, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Mainly fair, rain later in south.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, veering southwest later.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.
Rain then showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
Northeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3, then south or southeast 3 later.
Smooth or slight.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, veering southwest 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate.
Fair at first, then occasional rain, showers later.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
Variable, becoming southeast later, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
24 hour forecast:
Variable, becoming southerly later, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 4 or 5.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in the North Channel.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

In north, northeasterly veering easterly, 3 or 4, in south, variable becoming southerly, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in west.

Showers, rain later.

Moderate or good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly, becoming variable later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far north.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northeast 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, but moderate in far north.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly, becoming variable later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northeast 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Monday 04 Jun 2012 at 0600 UTC until Monday 04 Jun 2012 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge to the west of Shetland will decline. A complex low over Scandinavia will fill in situ.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

North or northwest 5 or 6, occasionally 4 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 04 Jun until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 05

Jun:

North or northwest 4 or 5 decreasing 2 or 3.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 5 or 6, soon veering north decreasing 3 or 4 by midday and 1 to 3 during the afternoon, becoming variable this evening, then southeast to south by midnight, increasing 4 Tuesday morning.

Rough moderating slowly.

Occasional rain or drizzle clearing during the morning further rain spreading from the west by midnight.

Moderate to poor in rain or drizzle, otherwise good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast to south 4 or 5, perhaps locally 6, veering southwest in the evening.

Moderate to rather rough with a swell.

Rain, perhaps heavy at times, clearing later on Tuesday to occasional showers.

Moderate to poor in rain, otherwise good.
