Forecast for Sunday 06 Nov 2022

Weather: Dry with clear spells during the early hours, but patchy mist and fog possible in the dales. Thickening and lowering cloud with showers or longer outbreaks of rain during the morning, heavy at times with a small risk of the odd thunderstorm. The showers more scattered in the afternoon with some drier and bright spells. Showers continuing through the evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 70%

Low Cloud and visibility: Occasional or extensive cloud during daylight hours, base 600 to 900m, patches to 300m possible. Visibility moderate or poor in rain, occasionally very poor over the tops, otherwise good or very good.

Forecast for Monday 07 Nov 2022

Weather: Rather cloudy with showers or the odd longer spell of rain, heavy at times. Strengthening winds with gales possible over the tops by dusk along with a severe wind chill.

Maximum wind: South or Southwest 30 gusting 50mph developing by dusk.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 50%

Low Cloud and visibility: Extensive cloud, base 600 to 900m, patches to 300m. Visibility moderate or poor in rain, occasionally very poor at height. Otherwise good.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 6 Celsius rising to 12 Celsius
At 600m: Plus 4 to 8 Celsius
Freezing level: Above the summits
