

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Sunday 07 Feb 2016

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Wet and windy with hill snow and local gales across parts of Scotland, but easing and turning showery later. Elsewhere, sunny spells and showers, these mostly in the west. More persistent rain arrives in the west/southwest later with gales developing. The rain clearing most parts by midnight with heavy showers following. Gales in the southwest, increasing severe later.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Sunny spells and showers on Monday, most frequent in the west and turning wintry in the north. Severe gales in southern areas from Storm Imogen, but these will ease through the day. During Tuesday the strong winds and showers will gradually ease.
