Forecast for Sunday 05 May 2024

**Weather:** A lot of cloud through the day with some occasional rain, although more in the way of drier weather developing as the afternoon progresses. Still the chance of a shower in the evening but low cloud will tend to thin.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** 30%, best chance from late afternoon into the evening

**Low cloud and visibility:** Widely poor in extensive low cloud down to 300 to 700 metres although this tending to thin and break from late afternoon onwards

Forecast for Monday 06 May 2024

**Weather:** Fog patches in the valleys at first. Otherwise variable amounts of cloud with the chance of some slow moving afternoon showers.

**Maximum wind:** Northwest 10 mph

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** 70 mph

**Low cloud and visibility:** Areas of low cloud below 200 metres at first, this dispersing by mid-morning. Then areas of cloud down to 900 metres shrouding some of the higher tops, but occasionally lowering to 700 metres especially in any showers.

**Temperature:**   **Valleys:** Plus 11 rising 17 Celsius  
                          **At 800m:** Plus 9 Celsius  
                          **Freezing level:** Above summits
