General Situation

Pressure will remain high near the faeroe islands maintaining a rather variable easterly or northeasterly airflow across the United Kingdom.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
High pressure to the north or northwest will maintain a Northeasterly airstream over Shetland and the surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil in operation at time of issue.

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time in east.
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight later.
Mainly fair.
Mainly good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Sunday 05 Jun until 0600 UTC on Monday 06 Jun:
Northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Slight or moderate.
Mainly fair.

Channel Islands
24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly or variable 1 to 3, locally 4 near the normandy coast this afternoon, becoming northeasterly 2 to 4 after midnight, further veering east by morning.

Smooth or slight.

Mist or fog patches at times, mainly this morning and from later tonight.

Good, occasionally moderate to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly 2 to 4, locally variable 1 to 3 jersey southwards, backing north to northwest overnight.

Smooth or slight with a low swell.

Mist or fog patches mostly clearing but perhaps persisting in the west of the area isolated showers developing in the evening.

Moderate to good, locally poor to very poor.

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
