Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0500 UTC to 0500 UTC.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney.

24 hour forecast:

Wind: southeasterly veering southwesterly 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10 in south, decreasing 6 for a time in north.

Weather: rain or showers.

Visibility: moderate or good.

Sea State: rough or very rough

Weather: squally showers.

Sea State: very rough or high.

Wind: southwest 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10.
Weather: showers then rain.
Visibility: good becoming moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel.

Wind: southwest 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10, decreasing 6 to gale 8 later.
Weather: squally showers.
Visibility: moderate or good.
Sea State: very rough or high.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: southwesterly 6 to gale 8, increasing 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10.

Weather: rain.

St Davids Head to Colwyn Bay, including St Georges Channel.

Wind: southwest 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10, decreasing 6 to gale 8.

Weather: squally showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: southwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 later, decreasing 5 at times in north.

Weather: rain.

Colwyn Bay to the Mull of Galloway.

24 hour forecast:

Wind: southwesterly 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10 or violent storm 11.

Weather: rain or squally showers.

Visibility: moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Sea State: rough or very rough, occasionally high in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: southwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9.

Weather: squally showers then rain.

Visibility: good becoming moderate or poor.

Sea State: rough or very rough.

Isle of Man.

24 hour forecast:

Wind: southwest gale 8 or severe gale 9, locally storm 10, decreasing 7.

Weather: squally showers.

Visibility: moderate or good.

Sea State: very rough or high becoming very rough.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: southwest 7 or gale 8 decreasing 6 or 7.

Weather: showers or rain.

Visibility: good occasionally moderate.

Sea State: rough or very rough.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough.

24 hour forecast:

Wind: southwest 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10 or violent storm 11, backing southeast for a time.

Weather: rain or squally showers.

Visibility: moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Sea State: very rough, becoming high or very high in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: southwest 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10, decreasing 6 to gale 8.

Weather: showers then rain.

Visibility: good becoming moderate.

Sea State: very rough or high, becoming rough or very rough.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel.

24 hour forecast:

Wind: south or southwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 or storm 10 .
Weather: rain or squally showers.
Visibility: moderate or good, occasionally poor.
Sea State: rough or very rough, becoming very rough or high.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: southwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first.
Weather: showers then rain.
Visibility: moderate or good.
Sea State: very rough or high.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point.

24 hour forecast:

Wind: southwest 6 to gale 8, increasing gale 8 to storm 10.
Weather: rain.
Visibility: moderate or poor.
Sea State: very rough or high.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: southwest gale 8 to storm 10, decreasing 6 to gale 9.
Weather: rain or showers.
Visibility: good occasionally moderate.
Sea State: very rough or high.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides.

24 hour forecast:

Wind: southerly veering westerly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 later.
Weather: rain or squally showers.
Visibility: moderate or good, occasionally poor.
Sea State: rough or very rough becoming high in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: southwesterly gale 8 to storm 10, decreasing 6 or 7 later.
Weather: rain or showers.
Visibility: moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.
Sea State: very rough or high.

Shetland Isles.

24 hour forecast:

Wind: southeast 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 6 to gale 8, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6 later.
Weather: occasional rain.
Visibility: moderate or poor.
Sea State: very rough or high, becoming rough or very rough.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: cyclonic 5 or 6, becoming northerly 6 to gale 8.
Weather: rain or showers.
Visibility: moderate or good.
Sea State: rough or very rough.

Outlook for all UK Inshore Waters for following 3 days: Strong winds, gales or severe gales will affect all coastal areas at times. A ridge of high pressure will bring a brief moderation of winds later Wednesday before further gales, severe gales or storms return during Thursday.

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
