Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0000 UTC Saturday 04 July to 0000 UTC Sunday 05 July 2015

General Situation

Heavy, squally showers and thunderstorms will spread northwards across the British Isles during tonight and Saturday. Fresher and mostly dry conditions will gradually follow from the southwest to all parts, although there will be further scattered thundery showers for many on Sunday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 near Sutherland, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Squally thundery showers for a time, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming east or southeast 4 or 5 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Fog patches at first, thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, becoming variable mainly southwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight becoming moderate.

Squally thundery showers for a time, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest, backing southeast for a time, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Moderate becoming slight.

Fog patches at first, thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, then veering southwest later.

Slight, becoming moderate for a time.

Squally thundery showers for a time, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest, backing southeast for a time, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight.

Thundery showers later.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time, then veering west or southwest 3 or 4.

Slight, becoming moderate for a time.

Thundery showers and fog patches then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West becoming variable 3 or 4.

Slight.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 5 to 7 veering southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Thundery showers and fog patches then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly becoming variable 3 or 4, then becoming southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 5 to 7 veering southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east, decreasing 3 later.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable mainly southwesterly 2 or 3, increasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East veering southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 2 or 3 later.

Moderate, becoming slight or moderate.

Thundery showers then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 2 or 3, increasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly at first in east, otherwise southwesterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 3 at times later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time at first near the Isles of Scilly.

Thundery showers then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate in west.

Showers.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast veering south or southwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers then fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South veering southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Moderate in west, slight or moderate in east.
Thundery showers.
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Easterly 5 to 7 veering southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.
Slight or moderate.
Squally thundery showers then fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East 5 to 7 veering south or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Slight or moderate.
Squally thundery showers then fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East 5 to 7 veering south or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or squally thundery showers then mainly fair.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South veering southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Easterly or southeasterly 5 to 7, veering southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5 later, occasionally variable 3 later in north.
Slight or moderate.
Squally thundery showers then fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly 4 or 5, occasionally variable 3 in north.
Slight or moderate in east, slight in north.
Thundery showers.
Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North

Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 5 to 7 becoming variable 3 or 4, then south 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Squally thundery showers then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate except in Firth of Clyde.

Thundery showers.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight later.

Squally thundery showers for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southeast 4 or 5 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate near islay and Tiree.

Thundery showers.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first, veering south 4 or 5 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Squally thundery showers for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming variable 2 for a time.

Slight or moderate in south, slight in north.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first, veering south 4 or 5 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Squally thundery showers for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming variable 2 for a time.

Slight near Sutherland, otherwise slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Saturday 04 Jul 2015 at 0000 UTC until Saturday 04 Jul 2015 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High over the North Sea will move north on Saturday as an Atlantic low pushes associated fronts from the south.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Variable 3 or less becoming east or southeast 5 or 6.
Slight, occasionally moderate later.
Mist or fog patches.
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Saturday 04 Jul until 0000 UTC on Sunday 05 Jul:
Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in west and 3 later in east.
Moderate, but slight in shelter southwest of Shetland.
Mist or fog patches at first, showers perhaps heavy at times later.
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor at first.

Channel Islands - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 4 to 5, occasionally 6, decreasing 3 to 4 by mid morning, becoming variable 1 to 3 in the afternoon, locally northerly 2 to 4 in the south and east of the area.
Slight to moderate, becoming smooth or slight by afternoon.
Isolated thundery showers and fog patches, clearing during the morning.
Good, occasionally moderate to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 1 to 3, occasionally 4 at first, becoming southwesterly 2 to 4 from mid morning.
Slight with a low swell.
Risk of thundery showers in the southeast around dawn.
Good, perhaps moderate to poor in any showers.

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
