Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will cover the south of the United Kingdom both today and Friday. Unsettled weather will affect the north, with strong winds and rain at times.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly veering southerly then southwesterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rough in north at first, slight or moderate in south.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Mainly southwesterly 4 or 5, but becoming variable 3 or 4 for a time.

Occasional rain, mainly in north.

Mainly good, but moderate or poor in north.

Slight or moderate.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5.

Mainly fair.

Mainly good.

Mainly slight.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Mainly fair.

Mainly good.

Mainly slight.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

West 3 or 4.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Slight.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

West veering northwest 3 or 4.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Smooth or slight.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Mainly northwesterly 3 or less.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Smooth or slight.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Mainly westerly 3 or less.
Fair.
Good.
Smooth or slight.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel
24 hour forecast:
Southwest becoming variable, 3 or less.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.
Mainly slight.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.
Mainly slight.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5.
Occasional drizzle.
Moderate or good.
Slight or moderate.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5.
Occasional drizzle.
Moderate or good.
Slight or moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near Lough Foyle.
Occasional rain and drizzle, mainly in north.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor in north.
Slight in south, moderate occasionally rough in north.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 4 or 5.
Occasional drizzle.
Moderate or good.
Slight or moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly 5 or 6.
Rain or drizzle.
Moderate or poor.
Moderate or rough.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides
24 hour forecast:
Easterly veering southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7.
Rain or drizzle.
Moderate or poor.
Moderate or rough, but very rough at first around Outer Hebrides.

Shetland Isles
24 hour forecast:

North 3 or 4, veering southeast 5 to 7.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor later.

Very rough becoming rough, but mainly moderate along east Shetland.
