General Situation

A weak ridge of high pressure developing over the United Kingdom today will move away east to be followed by a trough of low pressure moving across from the west later on Tuesday and during Wednesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast veering southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, becoming mainly fair.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

West 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4, then backing southeast 4 or 5 later.
Moderate, becoming slight or moderate.
Occasional rain then showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6.
Slight or moderate.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, backing southeast 4 or 5.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low centered north of Scotland drifts north, slowly filling, reaching the Faroe Islands towards Monday evening.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southeast veering southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.
Moderate, occasionally slight later.
Isolated showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 04 Aug until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 05 Aug:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3, occasionally 4 at first, becoming variable 1 to 3 jersey southwards this afternoon, then southerly overnight, increasing 3 to 4 by morning.

Smooth or slight.

Isolated showers.

Very good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 3 to 4 veering southwest to west increasing 4 to 5 overnight.

Slight becoming mainly moderate later.

Isolated showers rain from mid-evening, clearing by morning.

Good, locally moderate to poor in rain.
