for the period 1800 UTC Friday 04 June to 1800 UTC Saturday 05 June 2010

#### General Situation

High pressure covering the United Kingdom will slowly decline during this weekend, with low pressure developing over southern and eastern areas during Sunday, this will bring thundery downpours and a risk of gusty winds, by Sunday evening.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly, becoming variable, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Smooth or slight.

Showers at first, fog patches then mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair then occasional rain or drizzle with fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, becoming variable later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair then fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming north or northeast later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair then occasional rain or drizzle with fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, becoming variable later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair then fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming north later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair, then thundery showers with fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, becoming variable later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair fog patches with showers, thundery at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming north later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in south.

Thundery rain or showers with fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first near gibraltar point.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair then fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic, then northwesterly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6

later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair then thundery showers, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic, then westerly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.

Mainly fair then thundery showers, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, becoming variable, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming west or southwest, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Mainly fair, then rain or thundery showers, with fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming northwest, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate in west.

Fair then fog patches and occasional drizzle in west.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest, backing southwest later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate, but smooth at first in far east.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Slight or moderate, but smooth at first in east.

Fair then occasional drizzle and fog patches.

Good becoming moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair then occasional drizzle and fog patches.

Good becoming moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, veering west or northwest, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair then occasional drizzle with fog patches.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming northwest later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, becoming variable later, 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming north or northeast 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers then occasional drizzle with fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming north or northwest, 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers, drizzle with fog patches for a time, fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, becoming variable, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair then occasional drizzle with fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming north or northwest, 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time in North Channel.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers, drizzle with fog patches for a time, fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Mainly fair then occasional drizzle and fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming north or northwest, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Showers, drizzle with fog patches for a time, mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, becoming variable, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south.

Mainly fair then occasional rain or showers, with fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south.

Showers, fog patches at first, mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, becoming variable, 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair then occasional rain or showers, with fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, fog patches at first, mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Friday 04 Jun 2010 at 1800 UTC until Saturday 05 Jun 2010 at 0600 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure to the north of Shetland continues to extend a ridge across Shetland waters as it drifts

north through the next day. A weakening front will drift towards the west of Shetland later Saturday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in the west, backing

northeasterly in the far east.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in the east.  
Mainly fair, isolated mist patches in the west.  
Good, perhaps locally poor in the west.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Saturday 05 Jun until 1800 UTC on Saturday 05 Jun:

Northeast in the far east, otherwise easterly or southeasterly, 3 or 4, but 5 in the west at first.

Slight or moderate.

Fair in the east, mist patches in the west increasing with rain or drizzle later.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor in the west.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or variable 1 to 3 this evening becoming west to northwest by morning, increasing 3 in the afternoon, perhaps locally 4 later.

Slight.

Some sea fog patches tomorrow risk of a shower later.

Good but locally very poor in sea fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 3, occasionally 4, increasing 4 Sunday morning, locally 5 in the afternoon.

Slight becoming moderate.

Occasional showers, mostly overnight some sea fog patches, clearing on Sunday.

Good but locally moderate to very poor.

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
