for the period 1800 UTC Sunday 04 October to 1800 UTC Monday 05 October 2015

#### General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will bring unsettled and at times windy weather to all areas during the next few days.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4 at first in east, otherwise 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.  
Smooth or slight at first in east, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 later in far northeast.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough in northeast.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate, then moderate or rough later.

Occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in northeast.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough later in northeast.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 later.

Slight becoming moderate or rough later.

Occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times.

Moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Fair then occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast backing east later, 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, thundery later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Fair then occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, thundery later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 for a time in west.

Smooth at first in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fair then occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering south 5 or 6, increasing 7 for a time.

Moderate, occasionally rough.

Occasional rain then thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast veering southwest later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 for a time.

Moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering southwest 6 to gale 8, then backing south 5 or 6.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough for a time in west.

Rain then thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South becoming cyclonic later, 5 or 6, then northwest 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough later in far west.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering south or southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.

Slight in severn estuary, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain then thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast becoming cyclonic later, 5 or 6, then northwest 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate in east, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain or thundery showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering south 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 for a time.  
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.  
Fair then occasional rain, showers later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast, becoming cyclonic later, 5 or 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain or thundery showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 for a time.  
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate, and moderate or rough for a time  
in north and west.  
Fair then occasional rain, showers later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain or thundery showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 5 or 6, increasing 6 to gale 8, veering south or southeast 5  
or 6 later.  
Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough.  
Rain later.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4.  
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast backing east for a time, 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 for a time.  
Smooth or slight at first in east, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming  
moderate or rough for a time.  
Fair then occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain or thundery showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North  
Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly backing easterly for a time, 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 for a  
time.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate, then moderate or rough for a time.

Fair then occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast backing east for a time, 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time in west.

Rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast backing east, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Smooth or slight in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain later.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East veering south or southeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first.

Smooth or slight in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast backing east, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain later.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East veering south or southeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first.

Mainly moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Sunday 04 Oct 2015 at 1800 UTC until Monday 05 Oct 2015 at 0600 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure over Shetland will move away north on Monday as a complex low moves east into the UK.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

South 3 or 4 backing southeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Monday 05 Oct until 1800 UTC on Monday 05 Oct:

Southeast 4 or 5 increasing 6 or 7.  
Moderate, becoming rough later in southeast.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 6 to 7 veering south decreasing 5 to 6 later this evening, then 4 to 5 tomorrow afternoon.

Slight to moderate in the south, occasionally rather rough in the north.

Rain clearing overnight scattered showers tomorrow.

Moderate, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 4 to 5, occasionally 6, veering southwest to west Tuesday afternoon.

Slight to moderate.

Scattered showers risk of thunder.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

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
