Forecast for Thursday 03 Jun 2021

Weather: A muggy start, with some cloud possible on hills. Variable cloud and sunny spells through the day, and the chance of the odd shower developing by the afternoon. Still feeling rather warm.

Maximum wind: Easterly 20mph gusting 30-35mph early hours, easing to southwesterly 5-15mph by midday.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 600m: 70% at first, improving to near 100%

Visibility: Patchy cloud obscuring tops above 500m at first. Otherwise Generally good views, but some distant hills remaining hazy, with views also decreasing along with any showers. Clearer conditions spreading east overnight.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 14 Celsius becoming Plus 23 Celsius
At 600m: Plus 11 Celsius becoming Plus 16 Celsius
Freezing level: Above summits.
