Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Severe wind chill at height.

Forecast for Sunday 07 Jan 2024

Weather: Some mist and freezing fog patches around the foothills early and late. Chance of the odd shower across northern ranges for the morning, snow level around 500m, but the vast majority of routes will stay dry and see prolonged periods of weak winter sunshine.

Maximum wind: Variable 15mph or less

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 90% in north, 95% plus elsewhere

Low Cloud and visibility: Good or very good becoming moderate or poor in rain showers, very poor in snow showers and within cloud with bases infrequently lowering 600m.

Temperature: **Glens:** Minus 3 Celsius increasing 5 Celsius for the afternoon
 At 800m: Minus 5 Celsius
 Freezing level: 300-400m
