General Situation

An area of high pressure will bring settled conditions to most of the United Kingdom during Friday. However heavy showers and thunderstorms will move across southern and western parts later in the day and across most other areas overnight.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming east 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first near Sutherland, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Rain or thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming east 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3, then south 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Rain or thundery showers at first, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 becoming east 4 or 5.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Rain or thundery showers and fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, veering south or southwest 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Rain or thundery showers then fair.

Moderate or good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 becoming east 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Thundery showers and fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, veering southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.
Fair.
Moderate or good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 3 or 4 veering easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Slight, becoming slight or moderate later.
Thundery showers and fog patches later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly veering southerly or southwesterly, 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming slight.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4 increasing 5 to 7, then veering southwesterly 4 or 5 later.
Slight, becoming slight or moderate.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east, becoming variable 2 or 3 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming slight.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 3 or 4 increasing 5 or 6, then veering southwest 4 or 5 later.
Slight, becoming slight or moderate.
Thundery showers for a time later.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 3 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming slight.
Mainly fair.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4 increasing 5 or 6, then veering southwest 4 or 5 later.
Slight, becoming slight or moderate.
Thundery showers for a time later.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate in east, moderate in west.
Showers later.
Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, veering southwest later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Slight, becoming slight or moderate.
Thundery showers for a time later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 at times in Bristol Channel.

Slight or moderate.

Showers later.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 for a time.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Thundery showers for a time later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly, veering southwesterly for a time, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.

Slight or moderate.

Showers later.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming east 5 to 7 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain or thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly, veering southwesterly for a time, 5 or 6, occasionally 4 in south.

Slight or moderate.

Showers later.

Moderate or good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4 backing east 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.

Slight becoming moderate.

Rain or thundery showers later.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast veering south, 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 increasing 4 or 5, then backing east 5 to 7 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Rain or thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly veering southerly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 for a time in north.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southeasterly 4 or 5 except in Firth of Clyde, then backing easterly 5 to 7 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Rain or thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 5 or 6 veering south or southeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first, backing east 5 to 7 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain or thundery showers later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 5 to 7 becoming variable 3 or 4, then southeast 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time at first near Tiree.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming east 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 5 or 6 veering south or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming east 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, veering south or southeast 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time at first except near Sutherland.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Friday 03 Jul 2015 at 0600 UTC until Friday 03 Jul 2015 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure builds from the south and then declines north later as an Atlantic low moves towards the UK.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

West or northwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

Slight, but moderate at first in east.

Mist patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Friday 03 Jul until 0600 UTC on Saturday

04 Jul:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming east or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight.

Mist or fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 3 to 4, increasing 4 to 5 in the afternoon, occasionally 6, veering southwest 3 to 4 by midnight, occasionally 5 in the west.

Slight, becoming moderate in the north and west of the area.

Risk of fog patches isolated thundery showers likely from late afternoon.

Good, occasionally moderate to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southwest 3 to 4, perhaps 5 in the west at first, decreasing 1 to 3 by midday and becoming variable for a time near the brittany coast in the afternoon and evening.

Slight, perhaps moderate in the west at first, with a low swell.

Isolated thundery showers, and a risk of fog patches, clearing early Saturday afternoon.

Moderate to good, locally very poor in any fog, becoming good.

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
