#### General Situation

A complex Atlantic low will extend eastwards across northern parts of the British Isles tonight with its associated frontal system clearing southern parts during Saturday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, veering northerly or northeasterly later.

Moderate or rough, but slight to moderate in Moray Firth.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, decreasing 3 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

Southwesterly, veering westerly later, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in south.  
Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

West or southwest 6 to gale 8, veering northwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in south at first.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, veering northwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, veering northwest 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, veering northwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 in west later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, veering north or northwest 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 6 or 7 in west later.

Slight in east, moderate or rough in west.  
Rain then showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering northwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Rough in far south, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly veering westerly, 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest, veering north later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, veering northwest 4 or 5.

Moderate, becoming slight later.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 3 or 4 increasing 5 occasionally 6.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering northwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight with shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, veering north 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

Southwest veering northwest, 4 or 5 occasionally 6, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Slight with shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, veering north 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering northwest, 4 or 5 occasionally 6.

Slight with shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, veering north 3 or 4 later.

Slight with shelter, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic becoming northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far south and in far north.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, veering north 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic becoming northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Rough or very rough.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, veering north 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

The moderate to fresh westerly flow veers northerly, as a frontal trough moves south over Shetland waters around midday Friday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

West 4, soon increasing 5, occasional 6. veering northerly 4 or 5, occasional 6 in the east, later.

Moderate or rough.

Mainly fair, rain or showers later.

Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Friday 05 Nov until 0000 UTC on Saturday 06 Nov:

Northerly 4, occasional 5 at first.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers, soon mainly fair.

Good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 in the south of the area to 6 in the north, locally 7 mid-channel.

Moderate in the south to rough in the north.

Risk of a little drizzle at first rain likely in the north of the area by midnight.

Good except in rain or drizzle.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 6 veering north by dawn and decreasing 4 to 5, backing northwest 3 to 4 during the morning.

Moderate to rather rough, locally rough in the north overnight, becoming slight to moderate.

Rain clearing during the morning then scattered showers.

Moderate to poor in rain becoming good except in showers.

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
