General Situation

A weakening cold front will eventually lose its identity as a ridge of high pressure builds over the United Kingdom from the Atlantic.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly north 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near Rattray Head.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at first near Rattray Head, otherwise fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first near Rattray Head.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming mainly south later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, but rain later in northwest.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later in northwest.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

North 4 or 5, occasionally 6 until later.
Slight or moderate in west, smooth or slight in east.
Mainly fair.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.
Slight or moderate in west, smooth or slight in east.
Mainly fair, occasional showers.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

Variable, becoming mainly west or southwest later, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 for a time.

Moderate, occasionally rough west of Hebrides at first.

Mainly fair, occasional showers later in far northwest.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest, backing south for a time, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time.

Moderate.

Showers, rain later.

General Situation

Ridge of high pressure will continue to build northeastwards across Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue

Westerly or northwesterly 3, occasionally 4 at first in north, becoming variable later.

Moderate, occasionally slight later in east

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Tuesday 04 Sep until 1800 UTC on Tuesday 04 Sep:

Variable 3, occasional northerly or northeasterly 4 in east.

Moderate, but slight in east

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to north 3 to 4, occasionally variable 1 to 2 in northwest of area, locally 5 jersey southwards early this evening, becoming generally northeast 2 to 4 by dawn, then northerly 3 to 4, locally 5, through tomorrow afternoon.

Smooth or slight, locally moderate in the south at first this evening.

Risk of mist or fog patches near the french coast around dawn risk of isolated light showers in the morning.

Good, perhaps locally moderate to very poor around dawn.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North to northeast 3 to 4, locally 5 jersey southwards Tuesday early evening and again on Wednesday afternoon.

Smooth or slight, locally moderate in the south this evening and late tomorrow afternoon, with a low swell.

Risk of isolated light showers on Wednesday.

Good, perhaps moderate in any showers.

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
