Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1800 UTC Wednesday 02 June to 1800 UTC Thursday 03 June 2021

#### General Situation

A thundery low to the south of Ireland will slowly move north or northwest and weaken before moving west into the Atlantic tomorrow. This will allow a southeasterly flow across most parts initially, to gradually veer round to a southwesterly flow during Thursday and Friday.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast, veering south, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 2 to 4 in north, otherwise easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight, becoming moderate at times.

Occasional drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly veering southerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight, occasionally moderate near Rattray Head.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

East 2 to 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Occasional drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East becoming variable for a time, 2 or 3, occasionally 4 later.

Slight.

Showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

East 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less, occasionally 5 at first near Gibraltar Point.

Slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or less, becoming northeast 3 or 4 later.  
Slight, occasionally smooth.  
Showers, perhaps thundery.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5, becoming variable, mainly south or southwest, 2 to 4.

Slight, occasionally smooth in south.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly southerly or southwesterly at first, then becoming northerly later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming westerly or southwesterly 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then northwesterly 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in east.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming west or southwest, 2 to 4.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Showers, thundery at first, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West veering northwest for a time, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers at first.

Mainly good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly, becoming variable for a time in east, 3 or 4, then

occasionally 5 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Easterly at first in north, otherwise southwesterly, 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less at times in the Bristol Channel.  
Moderate west of the Lizard peninsula, otherwise smooth or slight.  
Showers, thundery at first, fog patches at first in northwest.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in northwest.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 3 or less at times in the Bristol Channel.  
Moderate west of the Lizard peninsula, otherwise smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming south or southwest 3 to 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers, thundery at first, fog patches at first.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 5 at first.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair.  
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or less, then southerly 4 or 5 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in north and west.  
Showers, thundery at first, fog patches in west.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first in northwest, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north and west.  
Fair.  
Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast, veering south later, 4 to 6.  
Slight, becoming moderate later.  
Showers, thundery at first, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in west.  
Moderate, occasionally slight.  
Fair.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly, veering southerly or southeasterly later, 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later in south.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers, thundery at first, fog patches in south.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in south.

Slight or moderate.

Showers in far northwest.

Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly veering southeasterly later, 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in the Firth of Clyde.

Showers, thundery at first, fog patches in the North Channel.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in the North Channel.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 to 6.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East veering southeast later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming east or southeast 3 to 5 for a time.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far north and in far south.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 at first in north, otherwise south or southeast 4 to 6.

Slight, occasionally moderate in south.

Showers later.

Mainly good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly, veering easterly or southeasterly, 4 or 5, occasionally

6 later in south.  
Moderate, occasionally slight later in north.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly 4 to 6.  
Moderate, occasionally slight in north.  
Showers later.  
Mainly good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Wednesday 02 Jun 2021 at 1800 UTC until Thursday 03 Jun 2021 at 0600 UTC

#### Shetland Isles

##### General Situation

High pressure centred over Scandinavia with ridge extending across Shetland Waters maintaining a southeasterly airstream

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil.

Southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in west  
Moderate, but slight in waters east of Shetland  
Fog patches  
Moderate or good occasionally very poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Thursday 03 Jun until 1800 UTC on Thursday 03 Jun:  
Southeast 3 or 4  
Slight or moderate  
Fog patches  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor

##### Channel Islands

##### 24 hour forecast:

Variable 1 to 3, becoming west to northwest 3 to 4 for a time tonight, then becoming north to northwest 3 to 4 tomorrow afternoon in the far southeast of the area.

Smooth or slight with a low swell.

Mist and fog patches at first, especially in the north of the area occasional rain from later tonight until early afternoon in the east of the area.  
Moderate to good, locally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
North to northwest 2 to 4.  
Smooth, locally slight, with a low swell.  
Occasional rain from late Thursday night until mid morning on Friday in the east of the area.  
Moderate to good.
