Meteorologist's View

Forecast for Friday 05 Nov 2021

Weather: Cloud thickening overnight. Mainly cloudy during daylight hours, but mostly dry. However, patchy light rain or drizzle possible. Little change in the evening.

Maximum wind: West 15 to 20mph gusting 30mph

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 40%

Visibility: Mostly good or very good lower down, but moderate or poor at times at height, occasionally very poor over the summits. Extensive cloud, base down to around 900m, perhaps patches to 600m.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 3 Celsius rising to 10 Celsius
At 800m: Zero Celsius rising to 3 Celsius
Freezing level: 700m during the early hours, but soon rising above the summits.
