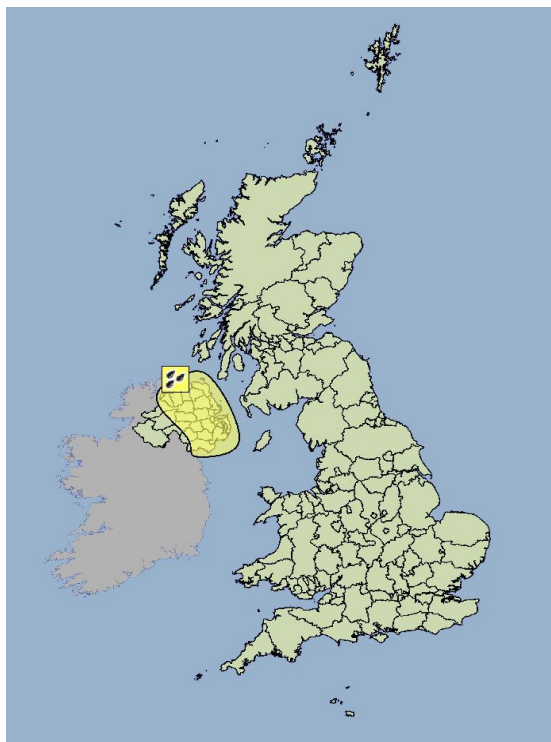




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

Heavy, perhaps thundery, showers are now moving north-northeast across Northern Ireland with the potential for as much as 15 to 20 mm of rain in an hour and perhaps up to 30 mm in 2 to 3 hours. The showers will clear from the west during the late evening.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **18:25 on Wed, 19th Jul 2017** until **22:00 on Wed, 19th Jul 2017**

Outbreaks of rain will move northeast across Northern Ireland this evening. There is the potential for some heavy downpours in the warning area but not everywhere will see them.

There is a chance of localised sudden flooding of homes, businesses and roads and low level disruption to transport.
