General Situation

Weakening weather fronts will move eastwards across all areas during today.
Thereafter, pressure will build with high pressure becoming centred over
Scandinavia during Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near Cape Wrath, decreasing 3 at times in Moray Firth.

Slight in east, moderate, becoming rough, occasionally very rough for a time, in north.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 towards Cape Wrath, but decreasing 3 at times in Moray Firth.

Slight in east, moderate or rough in north.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

Northerly veering easterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Smooth or slight.
Showers at first.
Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill
24 hour forecast:
Mainly westerly or southwesterly, veering northerly later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in east.
Slight.
Fair then occasional rain.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly 3 or 4, veering easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5.
Slight.
Showers at first.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis
24 hour forecast:
West or southwest, veering north or northeast later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time.
Mainly slight.
Occasional rain or drizzle, fair later.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North veering east or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 around headlands.
Slight.
Fair.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly
24 hour forecast:
Southwest veering north, then northeast later, 3 or 4.
Moderate, becoming rough for a time in far west, otherwise slight.
Occasional rain or drizzle, fair later.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northeast veering east 3 or 4, occasionally 5 around headlands.
Moderate in far west, otherwise slight.
Fair.
Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 4 or 5, veering north 3 or 4, then veering northeast later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough in southwest.
Occasional rain or drizzle, becoming fair.
Moderate, occasionally poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly east or northeast, 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, but moderate or rough at first in far southwest.

Fair.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight, occasionally moderate in south.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less.

Slight or moderate in south, smooth or slight in north.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight, becoming smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Isle of Man

Westerly backing southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough for a time in northwest.
Mainly fair.

Southerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.
Moderate, occasionally rough at first.
Fair.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south and in far north.
Showers.
Good.

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far north and in far south.
Occasional drizzle.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough for a time.
Showers.
Good.

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.
Moderate or rough.
Occasional drizzle.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Deep low over Iceland pushes troughs over Shetland Waters and maintains a southwesterly flow. Meanwhile a high builds over UK by Tuesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southwesterly 5 or 6.
Moderate or rough, building very rough in west later.
Rain or showers at first.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 01 Sep until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 02 Sep:

Southwesterly 5 or 6.
Rough or very rough.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northwest to west 2 to 3, occasionally 4 in the north, veering north by midnight and northeast by Tuesday morning.

Slight.

Mainly cloudy risk of a little rain or drizzle from this evening with mist patches, clearing by morning.

Good, becoming moderate for a time, locally poor in rain or drizzle.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast to east 2 to 4.

Slight with swell.

Rather cloudy becoming mainly fair.
