Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
It'll be a cold start this morning, with a risk of frost or ice in some areas. A band of rain, sleet and snow will affect south-east England, falling as snow on the hills and higher ground. Elsewhere there will be clearer and drier conditions, with the odd shower.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

By Sunday there will be sunny spells and patchy cloud across the whole of the UK, except Northern Ireland where cloud will thicken and rain will move in from the west. On Monday, it will be another day of sunny spells and thicker cloud at times, with perhaps the odd shower.
