Forecast for Wednesday 06 Oct 2021

Weather: Some cloud over the northern ranges into the morning before dispersing but most areas seeing some good sunny spells from the outset and for much of the day. High cloud thickening from west during the afternoon then thickening to bring some occasional rain in the evening, with hill fog developing later.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 30% at first in north otherwise 90% during the day, falling 20% mid to late evening.

Visibility: Generally good away from cloud, but moderate or poor later in the evening as the rain and drizzle develop.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Note sub-zero feels like temperatures at times on Munro's.

Forecast for Thursday 07 Oct 2021

Weather: Cloudy with occasional rain, some heavy, but some drier periods too.

Maximum wind: Southwesterly 35 gusts 50mph.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 30%, with the main chance of being in the clear in the northeast towards Bennachie.

Visibility: Occasionally poor in rain, but good away from cloud and rain. Extensive cloud 600-900m but only patchy at this height in shelter in northeast with higher cloud allowing brighter spells.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 13 rising to Plus 16 Celsius, locally 18 in the northeast.

At 800m: Plus 5 rising to Plus 10 Celsius.

Freezing level: Well above the summits.
