for the period 0600 UTC Tuesday 01 October to 0600 UTC Wednesday 02 October

#### General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will move slowly eastwards across Wales and southern England during Tuesday. Scotland will remain in a cool, showery northerly airstream, this then spreading southwards to all areas later today and tonight.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 4 to 6 backing northwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later in east. Slight or moderate in Moray Firth, but elsewhere moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate in Moray Firth, but elsewhere moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first.

Showers, becoming fair later.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly backing northwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in north, perhaps gale 8 later near Rattray Head.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough in far north and far south.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first in north, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate in Firth of Forth, but elsewhere moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first near Rattray Head.

Showers in north, fair in south.

Good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7 backing north 4 to 6, then northwest 5 to 7 later.

Moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough, becoming moderate later.

Showers then fair.

Good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 4 to 6 becoming northeast 5 to 7, then backing northwest later.

Moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming moderate later.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly becoming cyclonic 3 to 5, then becoming northerly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time later.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 5 to 7 backing northwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 3 later.

Moderate or rough until later near northeast Norfolk, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers, becoming fair later.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first, veering northerly 5 to 7 later, perhaps gale 8 for a time later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in east.

Thundery showers, becoming fair later.

Good, occasionally poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 5 or 6 backing northwesterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Moderate becoming slight.

Fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first, then veering north later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers, perhaps thundery, becoming fair later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5 becoming variable 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly veering northwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time later in west, then veering northerly 4 to 6 later.

Moderate or rough in east, rough or very rough in west.

Showers, perhaps thundery, becoming fair later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming southerly 4 or 5 later in west.

Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly veering northerly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in west, perhaps gale 8 for a time later in far west.

Slight or moderate in east, mainly moderate or rough in west, but occasionally very rough in far west.

Showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 or less, then southeast 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in west.

Mainly fair.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest becoming cyclonic 3 to 5, then becoming northeast 6 to gale 8, backing north 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time, occasionally very rough for a time near western Anglesey and pembrokeshire.

Showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or less, then southeast 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 4 to 6 at first in south, otherwise northeasterly 6 to gale 8, backing northerly 3 to 5 later.

Moderate or rough at first in northwest and near great orme's head, otherwise slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, becoming mainly fair later.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5 backing northwest 3 or 4, then becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 6 to gale 8 becoming northeast 7 to severe gale 9, then backing north 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in north, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain then mainly fair.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5 backing northwest 3 or 4, then becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first in southeast,

backing northerly 4 to 6.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in southeast, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain then showers.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 or less, then southeast 4 later.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 6 to gale 8 backing northerly 4 to 6.

Moderate or rough at first in North Channel, otherwise slight or moderate.

Rain then fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 or 5 backing northwesterly 3 or 4, then becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate at first in North Channel, otherwise smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly backing northerly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first in south.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North backing northwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then southeast 4 later.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight.

Showers then fair.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast backing north, 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough in north.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 2 to 4, then southeast 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in south but becoming rough at times in far north.

Showers, becoming fair later.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast backing north, 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate between barra and canna, but elsewhere moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 2 to 4, then southeast 3 to 5 later.  
Slight or moderate in south, moderate or rough in north.  
Showers, becoming fair later.  
Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Tuesday 01 Oct 2019 at 0600 UTC until Tuesday 01 Oct 2019 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low over Finland maintaining a brisk and showery northerly flow.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

North or northwest 5 to 7.  
Rough or very rough.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Tuesday 01 Oct until 0600 UTC on Wednesday 02 Oct:

North or northwest 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 at times.  
Rough or very rough.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 to 6, locally 7 at times this morning, veering westerly by evening, then northerly by midnight, decreasing 4 or 5 later.  
Moderate or rough, decreasing slight or moderate overnight.  
Scattered showers, locally heavy with a risk of hail and thunder, becoming lighter by midnight and dying out later.  
Good, occasionally moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 or 4 by noon, becoming variable 1 to 3 for a time overnight, then southerly 2 to 4 by Thursday morning.  
Slight or moderate, perhaps locally rather rough at first, decreasing smooth or slight by evening, with a low swell.  
Fair.  
Good.

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
