Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Saturday 05 October to 0600 UTC Sunday 06 October 2019

#### General Situation

An Atlantic frontal system will steadily move in to affect the British Isles over the weekend, while high pressure becomes slow-moving over Scandinavia.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 4 or 5 at first in Moray Firth, otherwise southeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later near Orkney.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later near Orkney.

Moderate or rough.

Rain at first.

Moderate becoming good.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 4 or 5, veering southeast 4 to 6, occasionally 7 near Rattray Head.

Moderate, becoming rough in north.

Showers at first, then rain at times.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later near Rattray Head.

Moderate or rough.

Rain at first.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming southeast 4 or 5, then increasing 6 later.

Moderate.

Fair at first, then rain at times.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 6, decreasing 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Moderate.

Rain at first.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming southeast 4 or 5, then increasing 6 later.

Slight at first in south, otherwise moderate.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 to 7, backing east 4 or 5, then veering southeast later.

Moderate.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 2 to 4, veering southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in north.

Slight, becoming moderate later in north.

Showers at first, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7, then easterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight at first in south, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly veering southeasterly 2 to 4, then veering southerly 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers at first, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 4 or 5, veering westerly 5 to 7, then veering northeasterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast veering south 2 to 4, then veering west or southwest 4 to 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional drizzle, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 5 or 6, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at first, then showers, fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming southwest 4 or 5, then veering west or northwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, but moderate or rough west of Lizard Point.

Rain or drizzle at times, fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, backing southwest later, and increasing 6 later near Isles of Scilly.

Slight or moderate, but moderate or rough west of Lizard Point.

Showers at first, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming south 4 to 6, then veering west or northwest later.

Moderate or rough in west, but slight or moderate in east.

Rain or drizzle at times, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, backing south 4 to 6 later.

Moderate or rough in west, but slight or moderate in east.  
Showers at first, rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southeast 4 or 5, veering west or northwest 5 or 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain or drizzle at times.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northwest 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, then south 5 or 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers at first, rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming cyclonic 4 to 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair at first, then rain at times.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Cyclonic 4 to 6, becoming variable 2 to 4, then southeast 4 to 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers at first, rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast, veering northwest later, 4 to 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair at first, then rain at times, showers later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northwest 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, then south or southeast 5 or 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers at first, rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 4 to 6, veering northwest 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair at first, then rain at times, showers later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 2 to 4, then southeast 5 to 7 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers at first, rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 4 to 6, veering northwest 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair at first, then rain at times, showers later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 2 to 4, then southeast 5 to 7 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers at first, rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5 later.  
Moderate or rough.  
Fair at first, then rain at times, showers later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming south 6 to gale 8 later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough later near Tiree.  
Showers at first, rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south.  
Rain at times, showers later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming south 6 to gale 8 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming rough later in southwest.  
Showers at first, rain later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5 later.  
Rough, occasionally very rough.  
Rain at times, showers later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming south 6 to gale 8 later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough later in west.  
Showers at first, rain later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Saturday 05 Oct 2019 at 0600 UTC until Saturday 05 Oct 2019 at 1800 UTC

## Shetland Isles

General Situation  
A ridge of high pressure extending southeast across Shetland water declines north as a low pushes east across central UK.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue:  
Southerly gale force 8 expected later, issued at 15:45 UTC on Friday 4th October.

Southeasterly 5 to 7, but 3 or 4 at first in northeast.  
Moderate, rough in the west.  
Mainly fair

Good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Saturday 05 Oct until 0600 UTC on Sunday 06 Oct:

Southeasterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time in southwest.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in west.

Fair.

Good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 4, locally 5 early morning, backing west 2 to 4 by mid-afternoon, then southwest by early evening, increasing 4 to 5 late evening and occasionally 6 in north by midnight overnight veering northwest 5 to 6.

Moderate decreasing mostly slight by midday, increasing moderate tonight.

Showery outbreaks of rain becoming persistent and locally heavy from late evening, clearing to isolated showers before dawn.

Good, occasionally moderate, then moderate to poor in rain from late evening, improving good by dawn on Sunday.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 to 6, perhaps 7 at times in north till late afternoon, then decreasing 4 to 5 during evening and backing west to northwest 3 to 4 overnight.

Moderate increasing rather rough from late morning till dusk, then decreasing slight overnight with a low swell.

Isolated showers.

Good but moderate in showers.

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
