for the period 1800 UTC Sunday 04 June to 1800 UTC Monday 05 June 2017

General Situation

Low pressure will bring very unsettled and at times windy conditions during the next few days.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southeasterly 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic, mainly easterly later, 5 or 6.

Smooth or slight until later in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers, thundery at first, then occasional rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, mainly easterly 5 or 6, becoming northerly 6 to gale 8 later in north. Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough in north and very rough later in northwest.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South backing southeast for a time, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers then occasional rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South becoming cyclonic 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 at times.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly south or southwest, 3 or 4, backing south 5 or 6.

Slight becoming mainly moderate.

Showers then occasional rain.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South becoming cyclonic, then west later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4, backing south 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers at first, occasional rain later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast veering west 5 or 6, occasionally 7 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly backing southerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers at first, occasional rain later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly veering westerly, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly backing southerly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly veering westerly, 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first, but increasing gale 8 at times later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Rain later.

Good becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering west or northwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain, squally showers later.

Moderate, occasionally poor, becoming good later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 later, then veering northwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough later in west.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate, occasionally poor, becoming mainly good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing south, then becoming cyclonic later, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic becoming west or northwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough later.
Rain then squally showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest becoming cyclonic later, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Fair then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, becoming north or northwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8, backing west 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, then becoming cyclonic later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time.

Showers then occasional rain.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic becoming northwest 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5 increasing 5 to 7 for a time, veering northwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight becoming moderate, occasionally rough.

Fair then rain.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 or 6.

Mainly moderate.

Rain at first, then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in southeast, then becoming northwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time in southeast.

Rain then showers.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6, then becoming northwesterly 4 or

5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain then showers.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6, then north or northwest 4 or 5 later.
Mainly moderate.
Showers, rain for a time.
Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8.
Moderate, becoming rough later.
Showers, occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate.

The Minch
24 hour forecast:
South becoming cyclonic later, 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 for a time.
Smooth or slight until later in central areas, otherwise slight or moderate.
Showers then occasional rain.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming northeast 5 or 6, then backing north 6 to gale 8 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, and rough or very rough later in north.
Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath
24 hour forecast:
South becoming cyclonic later, 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 for a time.
Moderate.
Showers then occasional rain.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming northeast 5 or 6, then backing north 6 to gale 8 later.
Moderate, becoming rough or very rough later.
Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Sunday 04 Jun 2017 at 1800 UTC until Monday 05 Jun 2017 at 0600 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Very quiet throughout.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Variable 3 or less, becoming east or southeast 3 or 4.
Slight in sheltered east, otherwise moderate.
Showers at first.
Good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Monday 05 Jun until 1800 UTC on Monday 05 Jun:
East or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Slight in sheltered east, otherwise moderate.
Showers later.
Good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 2 to 4, backing southwest to south 4 to 5 overnight then southerly 5 to 6 by midday, increasing 6 to 7 in the afternoon, then 7 to gale 8 by evening.

Slight, occasionally moderate, becoming moderate to rather rough by midday Monday, then rather rough to rough by evening.

Isolated showers dying out overnight rain spreading in from the west from late morning, perhaps heavy with a risk of thunder.

Good or very good, locally moderate in showers, becoming moderate to poor in rain.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 7 to gale 8, veering west to northwest 6 to 7 in the evening, perhaps occasionally gale 8.

Rather rough to rough, becoming rough Tuesday morning.

Rain, perhaps heavy with a risk of thunder, clearing around midnight scattered showers developing around dawn.

Moderate to poor in rain or showers, otherwise good.
