Forecast for Monday 02 May 2022

Weather: Some low cloud, mist and drizzle overnight and early morning, this then lifting and clearing. Then bright with occasionally sunny spells and the small chance of a shower. Cloud expected to become more extensive later in the evening and lowering onto the tops.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 20% becoming 90% in the afternoon, but 40% late evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Occasional or extensive cloud, base well down at first, but this lifting and clearing above the summits by afternoon. Visibility locally poor or very poor at first, but becoming mainly good or very good. Lowering cloud and visibility again later in the evening.

Forecast for Tuesday 03 May 2022

Weather: Mostly cloudy with occasional rain or showers. Some drier and brighter spells in the afternoon.

Maximum wind: Southwest 10 to 15mph

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 50%, best chance in the afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Extensive cloud, base 600 to 900m, perhaps 300m at times late in the day. Visibility poor or very poor at times at height, particularly early and later in the day, but mainly good lower down.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 6 Celsius rising to 12 Celsius
At 800m: Plus 2 to 4 Celsius
Freezing level: Near or above the summits.
