Forecast for Saturday 02 Sep 2023

Weather: A chilly start in the glens with a few mist patches. These soon clearing then a sunny morning. Cloud and winds increasing through the afternoon but staying dry. A cloudy and windy evening with a little rain possible in the far northwest around midnight.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 95% becoming 70% in afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Early mist patches in the glens, otherwise good visibility for most of the day. Becoming increasingly hazy through the afternoon with patchy cloud affecting tops above 800m in the west.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

A settled morning but becoming windy through the afternoon with mobility becoming difficult on high exposed ridges and summits by evening.

Forecast for Sunday 03 Sep 2023

Weather: Outbreaks of rain or drizzle will move in from the west overnight. A cloudy day with occasional rain or drizzle, this may be persistent for a while across the northwest but some drier, and possibly brighter spells in the south and east. Very windy, especially in the morning, with strong gusts on lee slopes at times.

Maximum wind: Southwest 35-45mph, gusts 60mph, decreasing to 25-30mph gusts 45mph in afternoon.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 20%.

Low cloud and visibility: Often poor visibility in rain or drizzle with extensive cloud cover above 500 or 600m, but higher and more broken cloud in the east.

Temperature: **Glens:** 14C rising to 17 or 18C, locally 21C in east
At 800m: 9C rising to 12 or 13C.
Freezing level: Above summits.
