#### General Situation

A weakening cold front will move slowly southeastwards across the United Kingdom over the next couple of days, and eventually lose its identity across southeast England later on Tuesday. To the northwest of the front, a ridge of high pressure will build from the Atlantic.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4 later near Rattray Head.

Rough at first in far north, otherwise slight or moderate, but smooth or slight in Moray Firth.

Occasional rain at first in southeast.

Good, occasionally moderate at first in southeast.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4 near Rattray Head, becoming southeast 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, but smooth or slight in moary firth.

Fair.

Good.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, veering north or northeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, fair later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

Slight, becoming moderate for a time in north.  
Occasional drizzle in north, fair later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

Easterly backing northeasterly, then backing northerly later, 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in east.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill  
24 hour forecast:  
Northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 2 or 3 at first in west, otherwise northerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in east.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later near North Foreland.  
Showers later in east.  
Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 2 or 3, becoming north 3 or 4 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
North 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3 for a time.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 2 or 3, becoming northerly 4 or 5 in far west and later elsewhere, occasionally 6 later in far west.  
Smooth or slight, but slight or moderate in far west.  
Occasional drizzle in west, fog patches at first in far west.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in far west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in far west, becoming variable 2 or 3 for a time in lyme bay.  
Smooth or slight, but slight or moderate in far west.  
Fair.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 2 or 3, becoming northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5 in west and later

elsewhere, occasionally 6 later in west.  
Slight, becoming moderate in west.  
Occasional drizzle, fog patches at first in west.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in west, becoming variable 3 or 4 later in east.  
Slight or moderate in west, smooth or slight in east.  
Fair.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southwest 3 or 4, veering north 5 or 6, occasionally 4 later.  
Slight, becoming moderate.  
Rain or drizzle at first.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
North 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.  
Moderate, becoming slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or 4, becoming northwest 5 or 6, then veering north 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain or drizzle at first.  
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
North or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
West 4 or 5, veering northwest 5 or 6, then veering north 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain at first.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
North or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.  
Slight, occasionally moderate at first.  
Fair.

Northwesterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3, then westerly 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers later.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to east 2 to 4, backing northeast to north during the morning, increasing 3 to 4 in the afternoon, locally 5 at times, decreasing 2 to 3 by midnight.

Smooth or slight.

Risk of mist or fog patches near the french coast early Monday morning.

Good, perhaps locally moderate to very poor early morning.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast to north 2 to 3, locally 4 in the afternoon and evening.

Smooth or slight with a low swell.

Risk of mist or fog patches early Tuesday morning near the french coast.

Good, perhaps locally moderate to very poor in any mist and fog.

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
